Plasma Fibroblast Treatment Cleaning Protocol - Mobile Businesses

1. General Mobile Hygiene Standards

Unlike salon-based businesses, mobile practitioners must ensure they:

- Maintain a **clean and organised** mobile kit with properly stored sterilised tools.
- Have a designated clinical waste system for disposal.
- Minimise cross-contamination by using single-use disposables where possible.
- Ensure that the client's **home environment** is clean and prepared before treatment.

2. Pre-Treatment Cleaning Protocol

Before Leaving for an Appointment

V Prepare a Clean, Sterile Kit:

- Sterilise all non-disposable tools before packing.
- Store disinfected tools in a sealed sterile container.
- Ensure the **plasma pen** is cleaned with **alcohol wipes** and stored in a sterilised pouch.
- Pack fresh **PPE (gloves, apron, face mask, disposable bed covers, gauze, wipes, and disinfectant)**.

Clinical Waste & Disposal Preparedness:

- Carry a **portable clinical waste bin** with a **sealable bag** for hazardous materials.
- Have a **sharps disposal container** if using disposable needles.
- Bring a disinfectant spray or wipes for use at the treatment location.

Upon Arrival at the Client's Location

Set Up a Clean, Controlled Treatment Area:

- Request the client to clear a **small, well-lit area** with minimal foot traffic.
- Lay down a **disposable treatment mat** or disinfect the existing surface.
- Set up a **portable treatment bed** with a **fresh disposable cover** and **disposable pillowcase**.
- Use a portable trolley or disposable surface protector to arrange tools.

Hand Hygiene & PPE:

- Wash or sanitise hands thoroughly before wearing gloves.
- Wear a new disposable apron, gloves, and a face mask before touching any tools.
- Ensure the client's skin is cleansed with an antibacterial wash, alcohol-free, chlorhexidine or alcohol wipes before starting.

3. Cleaning Protocol During Treatment

Maintaining hygiene **throughout the procedure** is critical to prevent contamination.

W Hygienic Handling of Tools & Devices:

- Use only sterile disposable tips on the plasma fibroblast pen.
- Do not place used tools on clean surfaces—use a dedicated contaminated tray.

Waste Disposal in a Mobile Setting:

- All single-use items (e.g. wipes, gauze, masks, fibrella, gloves) must be disposed of in a clinical waste bag immediately.
- Used sharps/needles must be disposed of in a sealed sharps container.
- Avoid leaving any waste at the client's premises—always transport waste safely for disposal.

V Avoid Cross-Contamination:

• Do not touch **phones**, **bags**, **or equipment cases** while wearing gloves.

Practitioner Hygiene:

- Change gloves if they become contaminated or torn.
- Always keep hand sanitiser within reach.

4. Post-Treatment Cleaning Protocol

Once the procedure is complete, the area must be disinfected before packing up.

Cleaning & Sterilisation of Equipment

V Plasma Pen & Tools:

• Wipe the plasma fibroblast pen with an **alcohol-based disinfectant wipe** before placing it in a **sealed, clean container**.

• Any reusable tools (e.g. metal needles) must be placed in a **separate sealed bag** for later sterilisation.

V Surfaces & Treatment Bed:

- Disinfect all surfaces used (trolley, treatment bed, chair) with a **hospital-grade disinfectant spray or wipe**.
- Dispose of all used bed covers and pillowcases in a waste bag.

V Laundry & Waste Disposal:

- Store all used towels, cloths, or linens in a **sealable laundry bag** until they can be machine-washed at **60°C+**.
- Dispose of clinical waste **safely and legally** at a designated **clinical waste disposal site**.

V Final Hygiene Check Before Leaving:

- Remove gloves, mask, and apron, disposing of them correctly.
- Sanitise hands and any reusable PPE (e.g. face shield).
- Pack all clean and used equipment separately to avoid contamination.

5. Daily & Weekly Cleaning Schedule for a Mobile Business

Daily Cleaning Tasks (After Every Appointment)

- V Disinfect all surfaces, treatment bed, and trolley used.
- Vipe down plasma fibroblast pen and power cables with alcohol wipes.
- V Dispose of all clinical waste appropriately.
- V Ensure reusable tools are placed in a sealed container for later sterilisation.

Weekly Deep Cleaning Tasks

- V Deep clean and disinfect all mobile equipment, including trolley bags and cases.
- **V** Run an **autoclave cycle** to sterilise any non-disposable tools.
- Check the **expiry dates** of all disinfectants, cleansers, and treatment products.
- V Perform a stock check and restock gloves, masks, disposable needles, and disinfectants.

Cleaning & Hygiene Checklist for Mobile Plasma Fibroblast Treatment

• Before Leaving for an Appointment

- Pack sterilised tools in a **sealed, clean container**.
- Ensure the plasma pen is disinfected and ready.
- Prepare a clinical waste bin and sharps container.
- Pack a fresh disposable bed cover, pillowcase, and PPE.
- Carry a hospital-grade disinfectant spray or wipes.
- Ensure all hand sanitiser, gloves, and masks are available.
- Upon Arrival at the Client's Location
- Set up a clean, disposable treatment mat.
- Disinfect treatment area surfaces before setting up tools.
- Wash/sanitise hands before wearing fresh gloves and PPE.
- Cleanse the client's skin with antibacterial solution.

• During Treatment

- Use new disposable tips for the plasma pen.
- Avoid touching unclean surfaces while wearing gloves.
- Dispose of all contaminated items in a sealed waste bag.
- Maintain a clutter-free, sanitised workspace.

After Treatment

- Wipe down and disinfect the plasma pen, trolley, and bed.
- Remove and dispose of used disposable tips, gloves, and wipes.
- Pack used reusable tools separately for sterilisation later.
- Mop or wipe the floor if necessary to remove debris.
- Transport all clinical waste safely for proper disposal.
- Wash hands and sanitise any **reusable PPE** before packing away.

Additional Notes for Mobile Practitioners

- Ensure clients are aware of pre-treatment cleanliness expectations.
- Keep a **dedicated**, **organised** storage system for clean and used equipment.
- Regularly check **vehicle cleanliness** to prevent contamination during transport.
- Follow local council regulations for mobile practitioner clinical waste disposal.
