Plasma Fibroblast Treatment Cleaning Protocol - Salon-Based Business

1. General Salon Hygiene Standards

Before detailing the specific cleaning procedures for Plasma Fibroblast treatments, it is essential to maintain **overall salon cleanliness**:

- Floors, surfaces, and treatment areas must be cleaned and disinfected daily.
- Disposable gloves and PPE must be changed between clients.
- A strict **no cross-contamination** policy should be followed.
- All waste must be disposed of in **clinical waste bins**.

2. Pre-Treatment Cleaning Protocol

Prior to the arrival of a client, the treatment area must be thoroughly sanitised. Follow these steps:

Treatment Room Preparation

Surface Disinfection:

- Wipe down all surfaces, including treatment beds, countertops, trolleys, and stools, using a **medical-grade disinfectant** (EN 14476 standard for virus elimination).
- Ensure high-contact areas such as **door handles**, **light switches**, **and equipment handles** are cleaned.

Sterilisation of Equipment & Tools:

- The **plasma device probe** should be disinfected using **alcohol wipes** and stored in a sterile container.
- If the device has **detachable tips**, ensure single-use disposable tips are used per client.
- Non-disposable items (e.g. Metal needle tips) must be sterilised in an autoclave.
- Store sterile tools in a **sealed, disinfected container** until use.

V Treatment Bed Preparation:

• Cover the bed with a **fresh disposable sheet** per client.

- If using a reusable cover, it must be **machine-washed at 60°C or above** after each client.
- Use a **disposable pillowcase** or disinfect a reusable pillow before each appointment.

Mand Hygiene & PPE:

- Practitioners must wash hands thoroughly with **antibacterial soap and warm water** before wearing gloves.
- Wear a disposable apron, gloves, and a face mask (preferably FFP2 or FFP3 for enhanced protection).
- Gloves must be changed before and after touching each piece of equipment.

Client Preparation:

- Cleanse the client's skin with an **antibacterial wash**, **chlorhexidine or alcohol wipes**
- Ensure the skin is **fully dry** before beginning treatment.

3. Cleaning Protocol During Treatment

Maintaining cleanliness **throughout the procedure** is critical to prevent contamination.

V Hygienic Handling of Tools & Devices:

- Use only sterile disposable tips on the plasma fibroblast pen.
- Do not touch the plasma pen probe with **unsterilised hands or surfaces**.

Waste Disposal:

- Single-use items (e.g. gauze, wipes, gloves, disposable tips) must be disposed of immediately in a clinical waste bin.
- Keep a **sharps container** available for any needles (if used).

V Avoid Cross-Contamination:

• Do not place used tools on clean surfaces—use a dedicated contaminated tray.

V Practitioner Hygiene:

- Gloves must be changed if they become contaminated.
- Do not touch **phones**, **tablets**, **or other items** without removing gloves and sanitising hands.

4. Post-Treatment Cleaning Protocol

After completing the treatment, the area must be disinfected thoroughly to maintain salon hygiene.

Disinfection & Sterilisation of Equipment

🔽 Plasma Pen:

- Wipe the pen's exterior with an antibacterial disinfectant wipe.
- Remove the disposable tip and dispose of it in the **clinical waste bin**.

Surfaces & Tools:

- Clean the treatment bed, trolley, and any surfaces that came into contact with the client using a **hospital-grade disinfectant**.
- Autoclave or disinfect reusable tools (e.g. metal needle tips) before storing them in a sterile pouch.

Floor & Air Cleaning:

- Sweep and mop floors with **disinfectant solution** to remove any particles.
- Use an **air purifier** or ensure **proper ventilation** to minimise airborne contaminants.

V Laundry & Waste Disposal:

- Place all used towels, bed covers, and linens in a **separate laundry bag** and wash at **60°C+**.
- Dispose of clinical waste appropriately, following **local council regulations** for hazardous materials.

V Practitioner Hygiene Post-Treatment:

- Remove gloves, dispose of them properly, and wash hands with antibacterial soap.
- Sanitise any reusable PPE (e.g. face shields) before the next client.

5. Daily & Weekly Cleaning Schedule

Daily Cleaning Tasks

- V Disinfect all surfaces before and after each client.
- Vipe down plasma fibroblast pen, cables, and other equipment.

- V Change bed covers, towels, and disposable sheets between clients.
- V Remove all clinical waste at the end of the day.

Weekly Deep Cleaning Tasks

- V Deep-clean and disinfect treatment room walls, floors, and all surfaces.
- V Run an **autoclave cycle** to sterilise any non-disposable tools.
- Check expiry dates on disinfectants, cleansers and treatment products.
- V Perform **PPE stock check** and restock gloves, masks, and disposable items.

Cleaning & Hygiene Checklist for Plasma Fibroblast Treatment

Before Treatment

- Disinfect treatment bed, trolley, and surfaces.
- Prepare fresh disposable bed cover and pillowcase.
- Sterilise reusable tools or ensure **single-use items are ready**.
- Cleanse the plasma fibroblast device with alcohol wipes.
- Practitioner to wash hands and wear gloves, apron, and mask.
- Ensure clinical waste bin and sharps container are available.

During Treatment

- Use new disposable tips for the plasma pen.
- Avoid touching unclean surfaces while wearing gloves.
- Dispose of contaminated wipes, gauze, and disposable items immediately.
- Change gloves if they become contaminated.
- Maintain a clean and clutter-free workspace.

After Treatment

- Remove and dispose of used disposable tips and gloves.
- Wipe down plasma pen, trolley, and treatment bed with **hospital-grade disinfectant**.
- Autoclave or disinfect reusable tools.
- Mop floor and sanitise high-contact surfaces (e.g. door handles).
- Remove all waste from the treatment area and dispose of it appropriately.
- Practitioner to wash hands and sanitise reusable PPE (e.g. face shield).
